There are over 130 lots with Guide Prices ranging from £10 to £900. The catalogue includes some fishing that is exclusive and not normally available on a day ticket basis. This catalogue is also shown in our Annual Report. More lots have been added, however, which are not listed in the Report's catalogue – these will be highlighted on the website version at the end of each section and will be denoted with an 'EL' reference number. All of the proceeds of this auction will go towards supporting the work of the Anglers' Conservation Association.

Auction commences **9am Friday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2008**. Postal bids must be received by **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2008**. Internet bids close **5pm Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2008**.

**AUCTION** - We invite you to participate in our 2008 Internet & Postal Fundraising Auction. The auction will be hosted on the ACA's website where you can view the catalogue and make a bid for each lot via a simple online form. The lots will be on the website from 12pm on 16<sup>th</sup> May to 5pm on 16<sup>th</sup> July. The highest bidder for each lot at the end of the auction on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2008 wins that lot.

**BIDS** – Making a bid can be made via our website or by using the form on P56 of our Annual Report. It is effectively a 'sealed bid' process by which you place a bid for the most you are willing to pay for a lot. If you are the winning bidder, you will only have to pay the amount necessary to beat the next highest bid (£5 more). For instance, if you bid £100 for a lot and the next highest bid is £50, you win the lot but will only have to pay £55, even though you placed a bid for £100. If yours is the only bid for a lot, you will only have to pay the guide price + £5, or the full value of your bid if it is less than the guide price + £5. You can, of course, choose to pay the full value of your bid if you wish!

**POSTAL BIDS** - If you do not have access to the internet we can accept sealed postal bids. Your bid then works in exactly the same way as described above. Postal bids for identical amounts will be placed in the order received. **Postal bids must be received in the ACA office by 14th July latest: ACA, Eastwood House, 6 Rainbow Street, Leominster, Herefordshire, HR6 8DQ.**

**SUCCESSFUL BIDDERS** - If you win the auction for a lot, the ACA will contact you afterwards to arrange for you to pay the ACA the winning bid price by cheque or credit card within 14 days. Alternatively, you can use the Paypal system on our website. The ACA will also put you in contact with the donor of the lot so that you can arrange the details etc. If we do not receive payment within 14 days the lot will be offered to the next highest bidder.

Angling is mainly carried out from the bank. This is by far the best coarse fishery on the Lune with Roach, Bream, Dace, Perch, Eels, Gudgeon and Ruffe. All of these can be caught well over the specimen size, with Bream over 10 lb and Perch over 4lb not uncommon.
