

## Payment by Direct Debit

### ADAA MEMBERS

You can now pay your annual subscription either in \* 10 monthly instalments or annually by Direct Debit.

Paying by Direct Debit is simple. All that is required is that you fill in a form instructing your bank to make payments to ADAA.



Please note that paying by Direct Debit in ten instalments is not an option to pay for as long as you choose; by choosing this payment option, you agree to make ten payments, as per the schedule we send you, and you agree to pay the full amount of the fee for the season.

There is a small additional charge of 50p added to each payment if you choose to pay by Direct Debit.

For example, at current fee rates (2021), the following payments would be in force:-
