

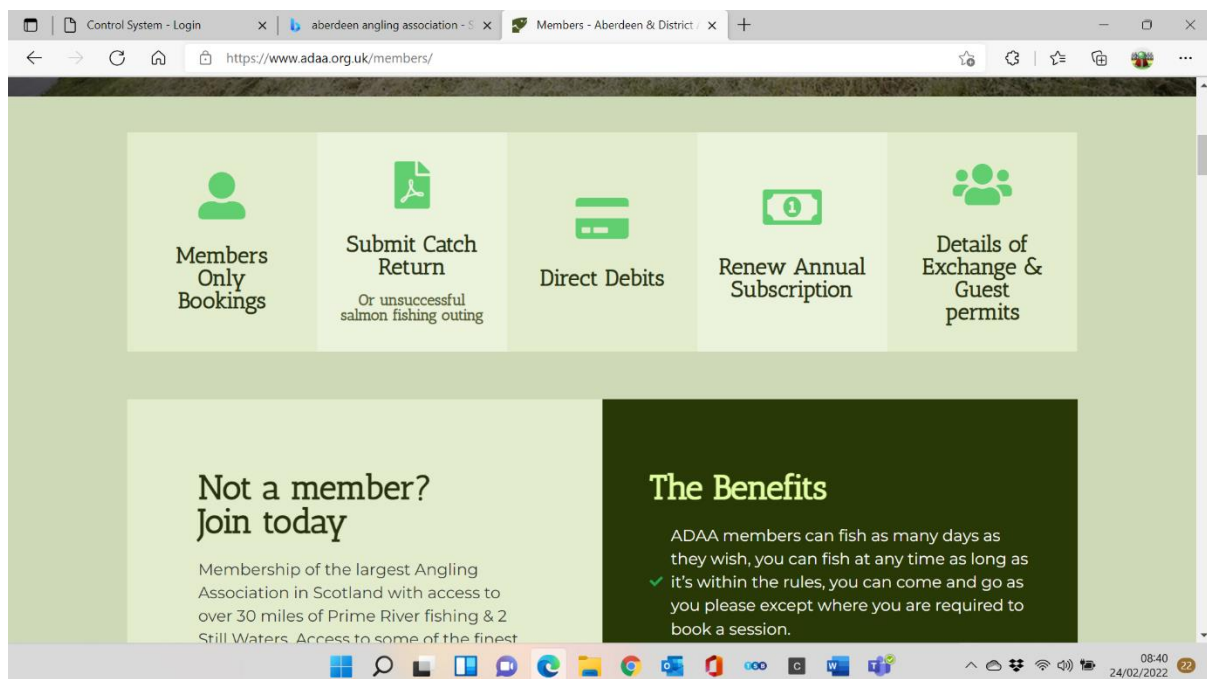

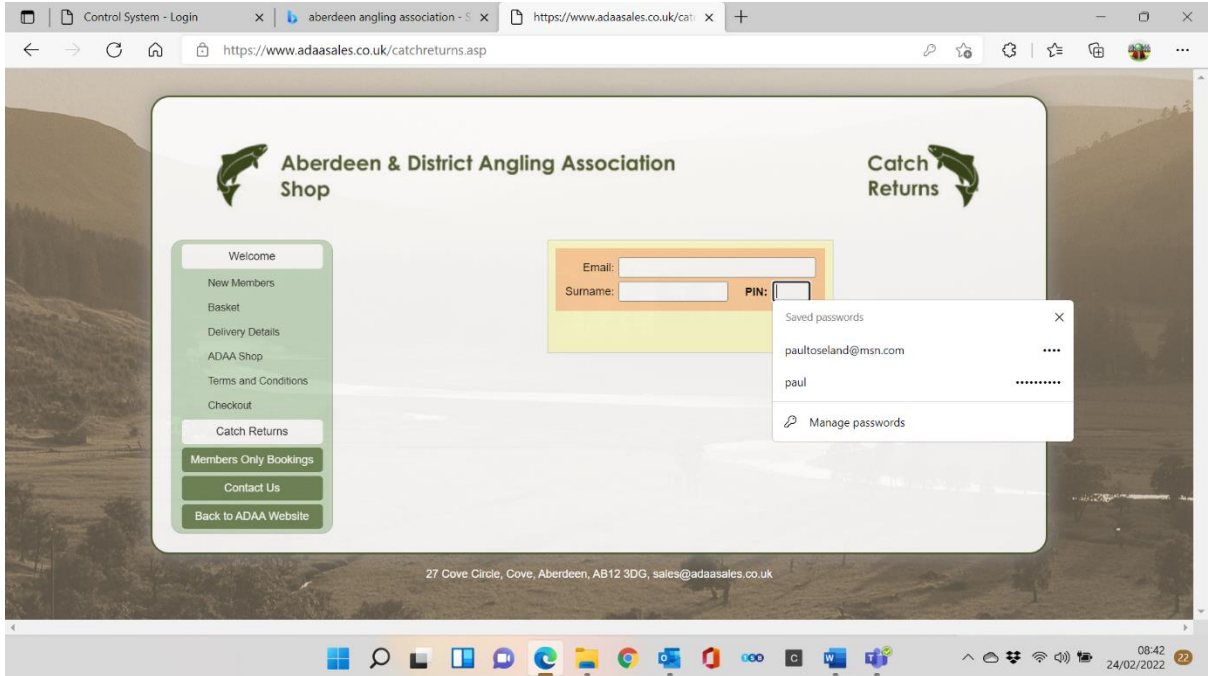

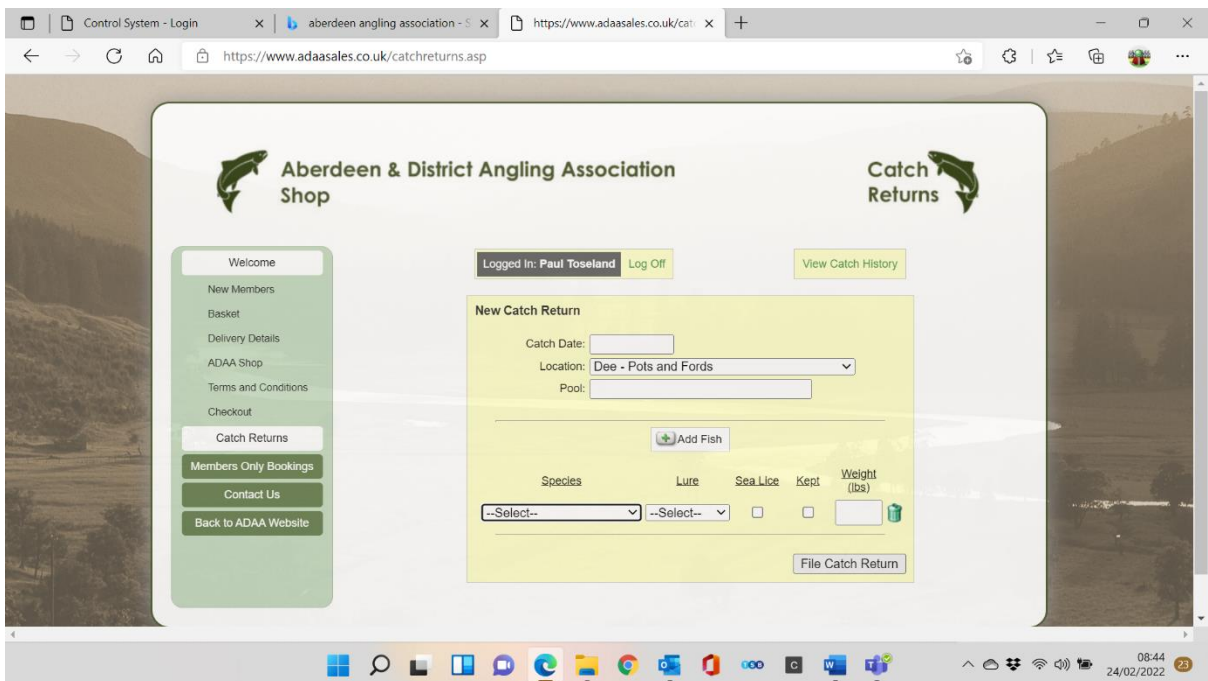
Click on Submit Catch Return or unsuccessful salmon fishing outing:



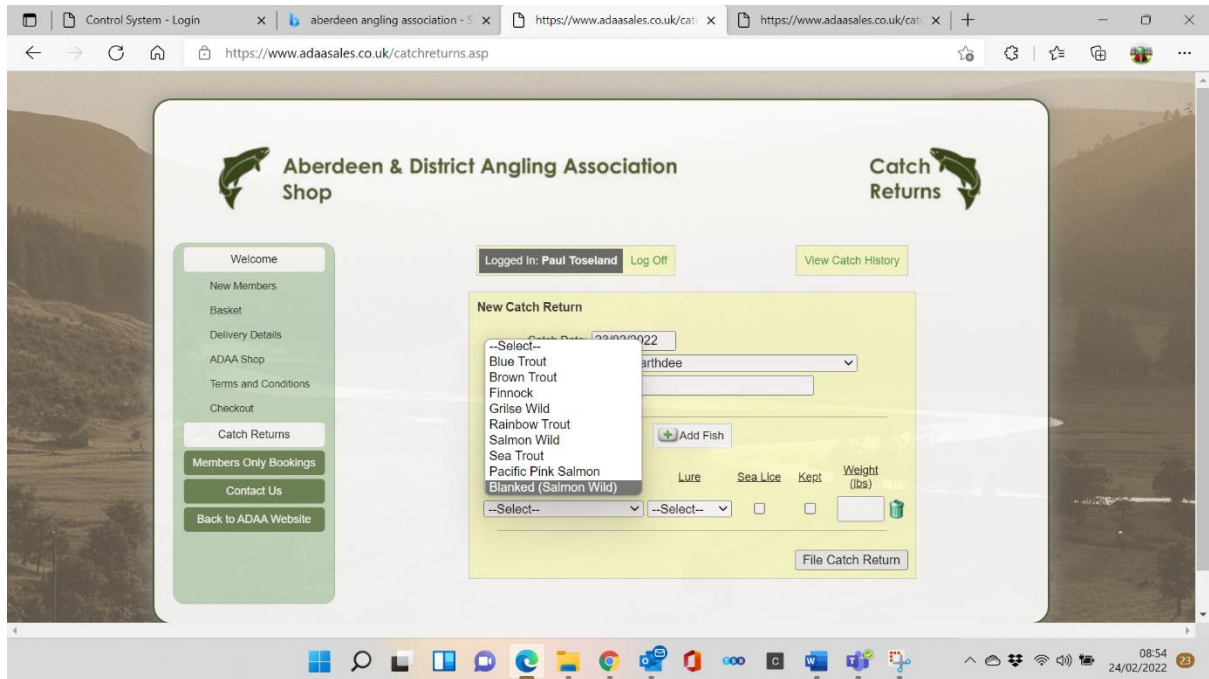

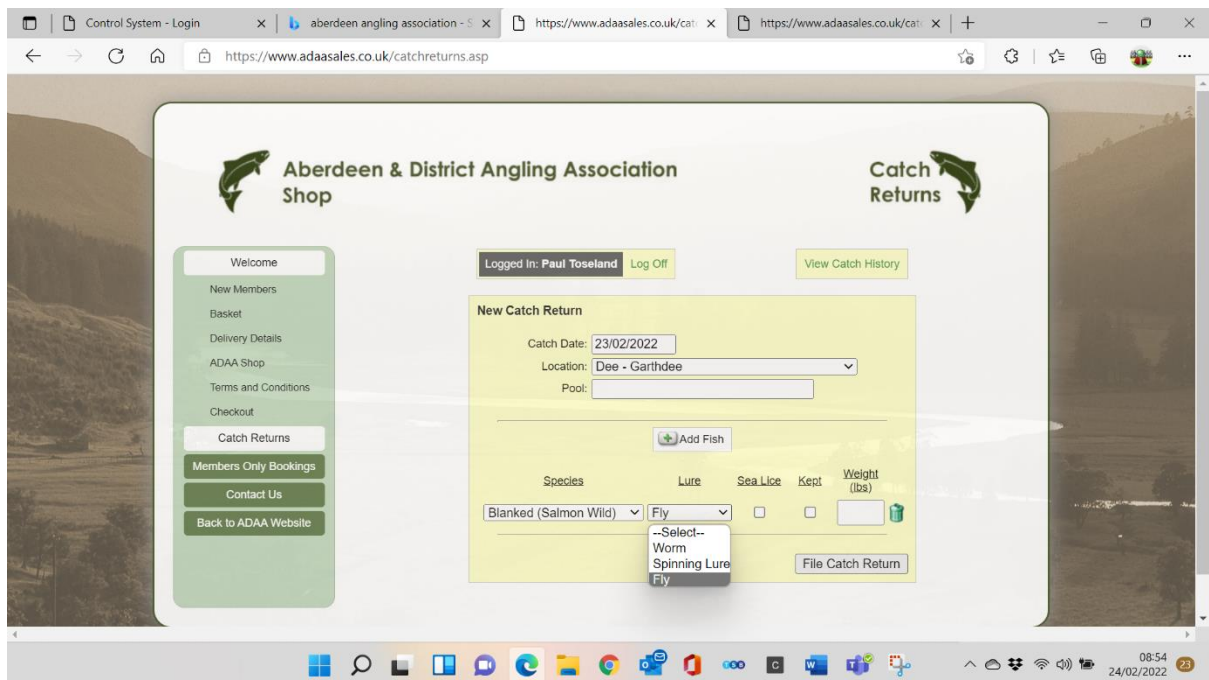
Enter the date you fished and which location from drop down list:
