Being a member of the ADAA entitles you the exclusive right to fish for salmon trout and sea trout on over 40km of river fishing on the Dee, Don, Ythan and Feugh, plus two stillwater fisheries stocked with hard fighting rainbow trout.

And there's more. The Association has a permit exchange agreement with Inverness Angling Club and the Loch Achonechie Angling Association offering members of the ADAA more fishing on the River Ness, River Beaully and fantastic loch fishing in the Highlands at no extra cost.

There are angling competitions both locally and away days visiting other fisheries throughout the season.
